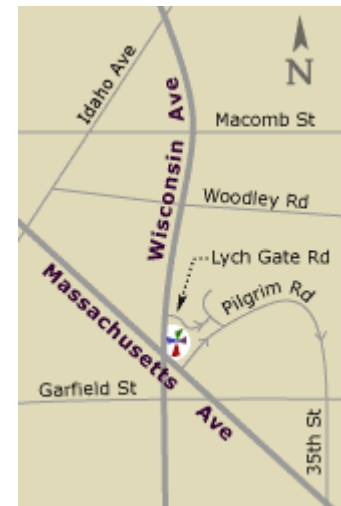
Palestine, Israel and the US: Why the Occupation Must End
